HOT LUNCH IS OPEN!!

We have now opened the hot lunch program for ordering. You can order lunch [on MunchaLunch.com](http://MunchaLunch.com).

Please note that a few things have changed since last year:

>>> With the exception of week 1, orders close 2 weeks ahead of the date of the lunch. This is to ensure we can get orders to vendors in time for them to make purchases.

>>> Hot lunches will now be Tuesdays & Thursdays. If your child is on a full-day field trip, please skip ordering hot lunch for that day. If your child is absent you have between 11-11:30am to pickup your order at the school. Please email rosevalleypac@gmail.com by 9am to ensure the hot lunch coordinators are advised of your request. Cell service is difficult at the school, so this ensures they receive it prior to arriving at the school.

>>> Munch-A-Lunch has changed its settings, and you now have only 1 hour to make payment on your order. If you do not make payment within that time, your order will be canceled and you will be notified of the cancellation via email.

>>> RVE is a pack-in/pack-out school and that includes the hot lunch program. Please ensure you are sending a lunch kit with your child on hot lunch days, so they can take home any leftovers and containers from hot lunch.

Our Grade 5's will be assisting us with delivering lunches again this year, as part of their fundraising for year-end celebrations. They are great at what they do and take pride in this leadership activity. However, on the rare occasion a mistake is made we ask that you please email us at rosevalleypac@gmail.com to ensure we can address any concerns you may have.

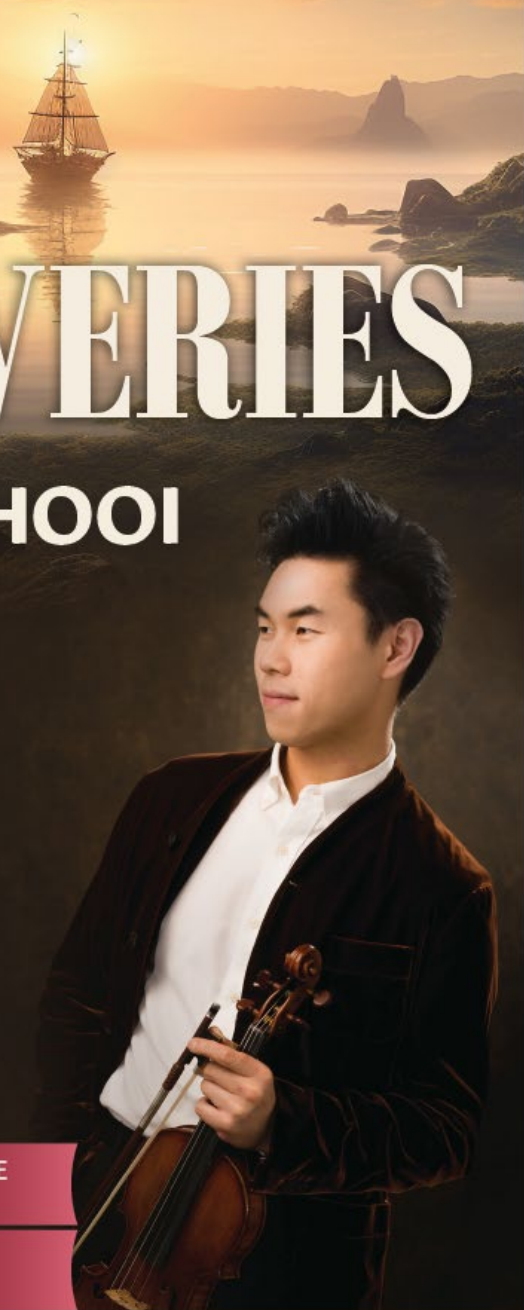
