Dear Parent/Guardian:

In British Columbia, the redesigned curriculum has motivated Districts to transition from "reporting" to "communicating" student learning. Rose Valley Elementary School will be offering a new way to communicate student learning which engages our families in ways that better align with BC's redesigned curriculum and that communicate and promote real-time student progress, reporting, parent participation, and student support for our families today.

FreshGrade, an e-portfolio software system, will be used to more effectively communicate with parents in an easy and seamless manner. Last year, a number of Rose Valley teachers engaged their classroom communities using *FreshGrade*, so this system will be familiar to many of you. This year, all teachers will leverage this technology in order to communicate student learning.

The objective of *FreshGrade* is to provide a secure web-based tool that will enable more effective communication and collaboration between students, educators and parents about student's work, learning and assessment at school.

You will receive an invitation to your child's FreshGrade Portfolio the week of Monday October 15th. By accepting the invitation you are acknowledging that you understand and agree to the following:

- All personal information disclosed to *FreshGrade* will be stored on external servers located in Canada and managed by service providers engaged by the School District.
- **Student personal information on *FreshGrade* will be accessible to the student's teachers, school-based administrators, and the student's parents.**
- Student content on *FreshGrade* will be accessible by students and parents using web-based applications from locations outside of the School.

The consent will be considered valid **from the date at which you accept the invitation to one year after the point at which your child no longer a student within the School District.**

Note: All school activities and learning outcomes that rely on the use of *FreshGrade* will allow for and accept equivalent means of student participation. At no time will a student be denied participation in a teacher directed activity as a result of a student or parent/guardian declining consent to the use of *FreshGrade*.
