- 2) Or you may come to the Book Fair with your child after early dismissal on Thursday. All Kindergarten students wishing to make a purchase are invited to visit after school Thursday with a parent.

The Family Event Draw (see entry form in the flyer) will take place on Friday, Sept 28<sup>th</sup> in the morning. You could win \$25 worth of books for your family – and \$25 worth of books for your child's classroom!
