International Education will be welcoming **grade 5 & 6 students** to the Central Okanagan in January. We are looking for families who would be willing to host a 10/11 year old girl or boy for next semester. In addition to attending school in our district, the students will participate in activities once per month and additional academic lessons three times a week. These activities and lessons will be supported by a local consultant who works in partnership with the students' home school in South Korea.

The students would like to live with a Canadian family and learn more about our culture while improving their English skills and studying alongside peers their own age. Students will be placed in schools based on their host families' home catchment area location.

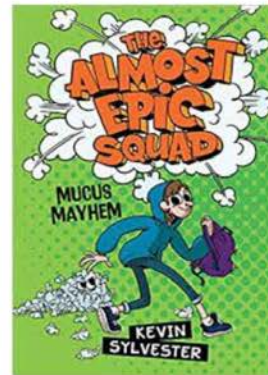

GRADE 4 & 5 SnowPass

October 2019

Dear Grade 4 and/or 5 Teacher,

It is time once again for the Grade 4 & 5 SnowPass!

Now in its 23rd year, families across Canada can continue to embrace the opportunity for their children to ski and snowboard for only \$29.99 + tax. The Grade 4 & 5 SnowPass is a not-for-profit program that is offered by the Canadian Ski Council and the Ontario, Quebec, Atlantic, and Western Ski Area Associations. It provides every 4th and 5th grader across Canada with the opportunity to ski and board affordably this winter!

SnowPass Specifics:

- SnowPass can be used 2 times at each of the 125 participating ski areas
- SnowPass is valid as soon as ski areas open for the 2019/20 snow season
- There are standard blackout dates at all the ski areas. December 27 – 29, 2019 and Family Day, February 17, 2020. Some ski areas have additional blackout dates and are listed on the website
- If you apply in grade 4, you can use your pass for 2 years and it will expire June 1, 2021
- Ski areas may require an adult on-site (recommended) or require a paying adult to accompany the student
- Students can submit an application online at www.mysnowpass.org

Skiing and snowboarding are excellent ways to keep kids active and we hope that you will once again welcome the Grade 4 & 5 SnowPass as an opportunity to provide students with extra-curricular activities that are healthy and foster a love of the outdoors.
